  - i. What three things did Paul speak to Timothy? Grace, Mercy, Peace
  - j. While Paul went to Macedonia, what did he want Timothy to do? To shake some of that teaching (verse 8)
  - k. Why did Paul desire Timothy to do this? To love to have a pure heart
  - l. What was Timothy's teaching like? To promote the Love of God
  - m. What does the word "charge" show in verse 3? It's a commandment
  - n. What are the fables in verse 4 referring to? Christian Doctrine
  - o. How can you build up your most holy faith? Pray in the Holy Ghost (Romans 10:17) Faith comes from hearing the word of God. Your faith and spirit moves to an inward higher to move you to a higher level
  - p. What is the end of the commandment? Good conscience and faith (verse 5)

"The Fruit Principle" is the inward life.

1. John 15:7-8

- Reveals the upward view of discipleship. A fruitless disciple of Christ is a contradiction in terms. There is no real fruit in our lives we can't claim to be the true disciple. The fruits we are speaking of is the Fruit for God and for his glory. Then it's for man and for others. This is manifested in two areas. Fruit and Character.

2. Galatians 5:22-23

- 1 Timothy 3:2 – Blameless – no two wives. You need to be sober minded, good reputation. Be above reproach. When they see you, they see the fruits of the spirit. Love, Joy, Peace, Patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. 1 Timothy – talks about a visual. A person who oversees a congregation. 1 Timothy 3:2 says if a person who is going to be an overseer of disciple has to be blameless. Has to be of one wife. Has to be sober minded. You have to have a great reputation. You have to take care of your reputation.

(In 3 months you will cross the stage in the main sanctuary. As you cross the stage there will be a panel of six Pastors and the ten core scriptures memorized. They may ask you one or two scriptures.) You have 3 months to become of reproach. You have to be above reproach. When people see you, they see the fruit of the spirits. A tree is known by its fruit.

3. Philippians 4:17

- People to see love, patience, kindness, etc. (the fruits of the spirit)

Last week we spoke that a Leader is going to be tested. (Target) - Can God mess up my plans? Pastor will look at calendars. He will see where you are available and if he will be calling you to serve. We want to make sure that people can see the fruit of the spirit inside of us. We want to be above reproach. Main objective is to build disciples to equip you to be ready to go out and equip someone else. You need to understand that even when you are struggling when someone comes and asks you a question and it will always happen that way. If you are struggling with your marriage, you will have someone to come and talk to you about "What can I do if I struggle with my marriage?" Even if your marriage is jacked up you are going to turn it around and you're going to give God glory in everything that comes out of your mouth. Ephesians 5 says that everything that comes out of your mouth should be blessings. Everything that comes out of your mouth should edify God and glorify God in everything that we do. Show others the fruit of the spirit. Remain humble and full of Christ.

Imagine the Tree – We are the branches. If you stay connected to the tree, then you become fruitful, then God comes and he begins pruning. He starts cutting things that are not of his. God knows what he's going because he wants you to continue being fruitful. Increasing our fruit and abiding in God.

##### 4. John 4:35-36

- Fruits are seen when souls are won for Christ. The way they are won by Christ is by concerned disciples. God is the farmer. The one who is in charge of us. He glad with us when he sees those things. It takes us to make a difference. God does not force himself on us. Stay connected to the vine. You will be fruitful. People will see that. Be the salt of the earth.

##### 5. John 12:24

- Unless the seed falls to the ground and dies. It remains one. It's not going to bare any fruit. Something has to die in order for something to grow. We have to capture our thoughts. We need to bring those strong holds down. Our flesh has to die. While in this class you will be tested. By family and God. Tests are good because it purifies you. It starts showing the real you. If you allow God to test you, prune you. Allow God to take away what needs to be taken away. You become a great disciple. You have to have a Shepard's heart.

God can bless you in the little assignments. When you are asked to do certain things, think twice be slow to speak. When God uses someone to tell you something. Ex. sometimes he'll use someone that you don't like. He'll use someone younger than you. Sometimes men don't like women to tell them what to do. See it as if Mary the mother of Jesus can carry the word and deliver the word, than a woman can carry the word and deliver the word as well. A test can bring great blessings.

Conquering the flesh – Strong hold is a mindset that accepts the situation as an unchangeable thing. It's set and it's not going to change.

As disciples of God we have to be full of Joy and full of the spirit of God. Galatians 5:22-23

We have to be faithful to God. Faithful at work. You don't work for your Boss you work for God. Don't entertain gossip. God changes you. You have to separate yourself. Be careful who you associate with.

Don't be entangled with civilians. 2 Timothy 2:4

Be a soldier of God. A soldier does not get entangled with civilians. God chose you.

Let God lead you and guide you. Let others know what God does for you.

The first will be last, last will be first – Matthew 20:16

A true Col. will survive. Don't be weak. You will be shaken and you have to be ready. - Amos 9:9

We all have to be great disciples.
